# RE: Update on Piping Replacement Project – July 2025

We would like to provide you with an update on the ongoing piping replacement project in our building.

#### **Work Completed:**

#### Laundry Rooms (Stack S32 – Riser R32):

- New sanitary and vent piping has been installed in laundry rooms on floors 2 through 6.
- A new isolation valve was installed on the 12th floor for the domestic hot water riser.
- Trap seal primers (to reduce drain odours) have been added on floors 3 through 5.
- Firestopping has been completed on most floors, with a small correction pending on the 4th floor.

### Corridor Drywall & Fire-Rated Access Hatches:

- Drywall reinstatement is complete in corridors for Unit 10 washrooms (S28-R27/28).
- Fire-rated access hatches have now been installed on floors 14 through 2 in corridors serving:
  - Unit 01 suite washrooms (S2/R2)
  - Unit 02 suite washrooms (S5/R5)
  - Unit 06 suite washrooms (S16-R15/16)

# **Work In Progress or Upcoming:**

### • Access Hatch Completion:

Fire-rated hatches on the 2nd floor are now installed, addressing a previous deficiency.

#### • Laundry Room Work (Floors 2–6):

- Some piping still requires support clamps and properly anchored studs these will be installed before drywall is closed.
- Domestic water riser insulation still needs to be completed. A follow-up inspection will be scheduled once this is done.

#### • Access Issues:

 Some unit isolation valves are currently covered by insulation and tape, making them inaccessible. The contractor is reviewing and correcting this to ensure all valves are usable.

## • Firestopping in the Sauna Room (Ground Floor):

 Completion of firestopping on the 2nd floor is pending new piping installation in the sauna room below.

#### **Outstanding Issues:**

## Access Hatches (Stack S5/R5):

- Some previously installed access hatches are not fire-rated as required. The contractor has been instructed to:
- Replace all non-compliant hatches from earlier phases.
- o Ensure all future access panels meet fire safety code requirements.

## **Project Status:**

Work continues to progress across multiple sections of the building.

- Minor deficiencies are being corrected, and most previously delayed access hatch work has now been addressed.
- The overall project remains on schedule.
